The UK Animal Law Conference

The UK Animal Law Conference is the premier event in the UK's animal law calendar. Bringing together lawyers, students, academics, NGOs, enforcement professionals and others with a personal or professional interest in animal protection law, the conference encourages education, networking and collaboration to advance animals' interests through law.

Now in its sixth iteration, the conference is co-organised by the UK Centre for Animal Law (A-LAW) and The Multispecies Collective, which is based at the University of Birmingham.
